
Reflect on all your learning so far. Identify one cause of Hitler's appeal to the German people.

Learning Gain:


By the end of this sequence of lessons I will be able to explain the appeal of Hitler to the German People.

Learning Steps:



- To review all the factors involved in Hitler's appeal to the German People.
- Explore how these factors link together.
- Examine how to answer an "Explain" exam question.

Assessment of Unit 1:

This will be a written assessment based around an exam question.

The exam question will typify a question 2a/3a which asks candidates to EXPLAIN.

"Explain why Hitler had such appeal to the German People?"

This type of question is marked out of twelve based upon a 4 level mark scheme.

Level 3: 7 - 9 marks: 58%(D+) to 75% (B) In this level answers will demonstrate the "Why" not just the "What" using appropriately selected material - in other words you will explain your choices.

There will be a minimum of three factors explained. Your work will be clearly expressed with evidence of organisation.

Level 4: 10 - 12 marks: 83% (A) to 100% (A*)

This answer will well be focused which identifies a range of factors backed up by precisely selected evidence.
IT WILL DEMONSTRATE GOOD UNDERSTANDING AND SHOW LINKS BETWEEN THE FACTORS.

It will be well written and organised.



In other words the best answers will LINK factors together -

this can be achieved by rank ordering, differentiating between long and short term causes, or how different categories such as POLITICAL, SOCIAL, PHILOSOPHICAL or ECONOMICs interlink.

You must also explain the link - just saying one exists will not get you a level 4.
