Hitler becomes "Führer" of Germany - 2 Aug 1934.

President Hindenburg appoints Hitler Chancellor of Germany.



For the Nazi faithful and the millions of Germans who had voted for Hitler it was a moment to celebrate.



Vice Chancellor Von Papen had persuaded Hindenburg and other members of Germany's political elite that Hitler could be used to destroy the Communist threat then discarded.

Feb 1933: "I have the confidence of the President. Within two months we will have pushed Hitler so far into the corner that he will squeak."

This was one of the most famous misjudgements in History.
